



WHAT TO BRING

Below is a list of suggested items to bring to campus to help make your new space feel like home. These are recommendations, not requirements. Please also review the "What Not to Bring" section; items listed there are prohibited in University Housing Services facilities and will be confiscated if brought.

BED ARTICLES

LAUNDRY ITEMS

TECHNOLOGY CONVENIENCE

- Power Strip with Surge Protection
- Phone/Laptop Charger and Charging Cables

- Noise-canceling Headphones or Earplugs

- TV, Gaming Console **streaming is common, so a smart TV or streaming stick might be more useful.*
- Computer
- Printer **Optional for most; we recommend checking campus printing options first.*

A GREENER PACKING LIST!

- Bicycle, helmet, bike lock, & lights
- Reusable water bottles and/or coffee cups *(ISU has numerous water bottle refill stations throughout campus!)*
- Reusable cutlery, plates, containers, & straws
- Reusable K-cup container *(if you are bringing a Keurig coffee maker)*
- Rechargeable batteries for game controllers or remotes
- Recycled paper notebooks & refillable pens
- Plant-based laundry detergent & cleaning products
- Sewing kit *(ISU's Fix-it-Friday initiative also does basic clothing repair for free!)*



NON-SUSTAINABLE Consider Leaving these Non-Sustainable items at Home

- Single-use items
- Aerosol cans
- Disposable items *(paper towels, plastic cutlery, paper plates, etc.)*

WHAT NOT TO BRING

For the safety of you and others in the campus community, the following items are not allowed on campus.

- Air Fryers**
- Large moving trucks or towed trailers
- Blender**
- Bottle or Can Collection
- Candle Warmer
- Candles, Wick Lamps, Incense
- Cinder Blocks *(all beds are adjustable)*
- Coffee Maker/Tea Maker** *(differer than a Keurig or Single Serve Beverage Maker)*
- Curtains, Draperies, or Blinds
- Electric Kettles**
- Electrical Lighted Window or Wall Signs
- Grill - any type
- Halogen Lamps *(includes the colorful multi-light (a.k.a. "octopus") lamps)*
- Hot Plate**
- Hoverboards (battery-operated scooters)
- Lava Lamps
- Microwave *(provided in Cardinal Court kitchens & in Residence Hall shared areas)*
- Pets *(except fish - nothing larger than 10gal tank)*
- Popcorn Popper**
- Sandwich Maker**
- Toaster/Toaster Oven**
- Cardinal Court Only: Mini-Fridge *(full-size refrigerator provided in kitchen)*

** Indicates items acceptable at Cardinal Court ONLY. Do not bring to residence halls.

All electrical heat-producing and cooking appliances, with the exception of hair appliances (except for single-serve auto shut-off coffee makers-i.e., Keurig), are prohibited from possession and/or usage in the residence halls.

Heat-producing appliances such as coffee pots *(except for single-serve auto shut-off coffee makers-i.e., Keurig)*, hot pots, personal microwaves, air fryers, and candle warmers are not allowed in residence hall student rooms but are allowed in University apartment kitchens."

Personal transportation devices (i.e., electric hoverboards, electric scooters, electric bikes, gas-powered bicycles, any device powered by Lithium-ion batteries, etc.) are prohibited from all University Housing Services residential properties (residence halls and apartments) unless the specific device is approved as a disability accommodation by Student Access and Accommodation Services."
